







Introduction




Population: 159 Million (Male: 132 Million and Female 127 Million)

Introduction

- Women are culturally required to be submissive and obidient.
- The primary roles of women are house keepers, childrearers and supporters for their husband.
- In Contrast, Men are entitled to power and privilege. Men are perceived as a leaders, providers, and protectors
- Traditional view on gender norms are risk factors for violence against women in Indonesia.

Men's Involvement in Violence against Women Prevention in Indonesia



- In 2000, A group of men who against violence toward women was declared in Jakarta.
- in 2007, there was a long march of men who against violence against women in Yogyakarta.
- In 2009, Aliansi Laki-Laki Baru (New Men Alliance) was formed in Bandung West Java.

Aliansi Laki-Laki Baru: The Men Who are raised by feminism


- Most the members of the alliance have long engagement with feminist movement

RISKS	RENSPONSE
Creating new domination of men within women movement	a. Put the group as a support for and part of women movement.b. Avoid to take leadership within anti violence against women movement.
Taking away resources for women empowerment programs	a. Put programs for men as a complementary for women empowerment programs.b. Help women/feminist group to raise fund/resources for women empowerment program
Colluding with violent men	Invite women to be part of the group to make the men movement accountable to women.


